Cambridge English examinations are a series of general English proficiency exams that are pegged to levels in the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).

The English Language Centre runs a number of [preparation courses for Cambridge FCE and CAE](#) throughout the year leading up to the examination date set by Cambridge English. The English Language Centre helps book students wishing to take the exam, whether they have taken a preparation course or not.

Students receive a score out of 100 which correlates to a grade at the CEFR level of the examination. Grades A, B or C are at the level of the examination:
